UPDATES

The board has been working diligently on some exciting changes. A new lawn care crew was hired for the current season. This will create a large savings to the association! A portion of the savings will be used this year for a few much needed grounds improvements. Some of the main focus areas that will be worked on/have been worked on in commons areas include:

- Removal of several dead bushes and trees
- Trimming up of several trees with low hanging branches
- Mulch added around twenty-four trees
- Dirt and grass seed placed on areas where tree roots are exposed.
